In his presentation, Michael will address the role of parents in supporting and supervising their children when using online technology such as Instagram, SnapChat and Facebook. The issues our teachers deal with relating to social media are happening outside of school hours and often with families who trust their children but do not check what they are up to. The fact that these social media apps are marketed to children from the age of 5+ does not always register with families who may be unintentionally putting their children in harm's way.
