

## International Student Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

### Procedure for granting and recording course credit

Ivanhoe Grammar School ensures the decision to assess RPL or grant course credits maintains the integrity of the qualification and complies with the requirements of the educational framework of the course.

When granting RPL or course credits, Ivanhoe Grammar School will give a written record for the overseas student to accept, and retain the written record of acceptance for two years after the overseas student ceases to be an accepted student.

If the Ivanhoe Grammar School grants RPL or course credits which reduces the overseas student's course length, they will inform the overseas student of the reduced course duration and issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) for the reduced duration of the course.

Ivanhoe Grammar School will report any change in course duration in Provider Registration and International Student Management System (PRISMS) if RPL or course credits are granted after the overseas student's visa is granted

Enrolment at Ivanhoe Grammar School is subject to the assessment of the school.  
Course credit may only be offered as outlined below.

For students entering from Year 7 to Year 10, entry into any course is subject to the assessment of the school.

Students enrolled in the Victorian Certificate of Education may receive course credit for units completed based on the assessment of the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority.

Students enrolled in the International Baccalaureate may receive course credit subject to the assessment of the school if the subject choices are available
