

## International Student Notebook Program 2019

International Students are part of the Schools compulsory Notebook Program

### **YEAR 10 STUDENTS**

International Students who start in Elicos and/or Mainstream Year 10  
The HP Elitebook G3 1030 notebook will be provided to students

Payment for Notebooks are made through the composite fee with instalments commencing at the beginning of Year 9.

International Students who commence in Semester 2 (Elicos followed by Year 10) or Semester 1 (Elicos followed by Year 10) will be charged an additional fee with their first school account. It will be itemised as Notebook Computer Fee. This fee will be calculated depending on the Year Level and Entry date

### **YEAR 11 STUDENTS**

International Students who start in Elicos and/or Mainstream Year 11  
Students have two options

#### **Option One – THIS IS THE RECOMMENDED AND PREFERRED OPTION**

Order through the school by following the links below.

This is the preferred method as it includes installation of School software, IT support and is covered under the Ivanhoe Grammar School Insurance policy for two years.

In the event the computer is lost, stolen or damaged, it can be replaced or repaired under insurance after the payment of a \$100 excess. Repairs under warranty are at no cost, and warranty and insurance claims should be made through IT Services and not by contacting the manufacturer directly
