Applicants are required to attach an essay of approximately 1000 words. This essay is to be written by the applicant and forms the largest component of this application. The essay should include the following three elements:

- (a) Why do you want to become a pilot and how important is it to you?
- (b) What previous flight training/aviation experience do you have?
- (c) Describe your present goals and how you anticipate achieving each of them?

Part 5 – Aviation Scholarship Information and Conditions

(a) Applicants must be Australian citizens and must be aged 16 years by the time that the Scholarship commences.

(b) Applications are to be submitted on the application form provided.

(c) A flight review assessment will be conducted with short listed candidates prior to the announcement of the successful applicant.

(d) The recipient of the Wanless Family Aviation Scholarship releases, indemnifies and holds harmless Ivanhoe Grammar School and the Wanless Family Aviation Scholarship Committee in respect of any and all claims arising directly or indirectly as a consequence of the application process and/or being awarded a Scholarship, including (but not limited to) any injury whatsoever sustained, or death arising, during an assessment flight, or during the course of undertaking training by the chosen Training Course Provider.



(e) The Wanless Family Aviation Scholarship recipient must utilise the \$6,000 Scholarship funds within 12 months of being awarded the Scholarship. The Scholarship will be paid directly to the training provider by Ivanhoe Grammar School upon presentation of flight training invoices.

(f) Should the Wanless Family Aviation Scholarship recipient fail to demonstrate ongoing commitment or fail to continue his or her training in a diligent manner, then the remaining credit will be forfeited.

(g) The Wanless Family Aviation Scholarship Selection Committee has the discretion not to present a Scholarship in any given year should the applicants not meet the criteria for the Scholarship.
