#### **SECTION 1 COMBINED TRAINING**

CT1.	EFA Novice 2.3	Max. Jumping Height 1.05m
CT2.	EFA Novice 2.1	Max. Jumping Height 0.90m
CT3.	EFA Preliminary 1.4	Max. Jumping Height 0.75m
CT4.	EFA Preliminary 1.3	Max. Jumping Height 0.60m
CT5.	EFA Preliminary 1.1	Max. Jumping Height 0.45m

- Section 4 & 5 will be divided into Primary and Secondary
- Dressage sections 1, 2 & 3 will be held in a 60 x 20 arena.
- Numbers 1 – 5 indicate approximate Pony Club equivalent

#### **SECTION 2 DRESSAGE**

**CT test to count as one test. Riders competing in CT ride a second test at the same level to count for dressage scores. If competing at a higher level in dressage, 2 additional tests to be ridden.**

## **RULES OF THE COMPETITION**

This event is affiliated with the Equestrian Federation of Australia. EFA membership numbers **must** be included on the entry form.

Students who are **not** current financial members of the EFA, and are **not** enrolled in an EFA affiliated School must include an additional \$20.00. This will cover them for Public Liability Insurance.

Ivanhoe Grammar School reserves the right to close entries before closing date if number of entries is excessive.

One horse, one rider unless numbers permit, at the discretion of the organizing committee. If there are insufficient numbers, classes may be combined, e.g. grades 1&2.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Events are open to all riders enrolled at primary and secondary schools throughout Victoria who have attained at least E grade Standard. (PCAV) or equivalent**
- 2. For the sake of good sportsmanship as well as safety, riders are encouraged to compete in their appropriate level.**
- 3. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to ensure that riders are competing at their correct level.**
- 4. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to eliminate riders deemed to be competing at an inappropriate level.**

### **CONDITIONS**

1. All riders must wear ASSA approved helmets and riding boots at all times when mounted. Long boots are permitted for riders.
2. School shirt, tie, jumper, sports uniform or tracksuit top and saddle cloth (if available) are to be worn with beige, cream or banana jodhpurs.
3. Each team must be accompanied by a staff member or nominated parent who will act as team manager and will be responsible for the riders during the competition
- 4. Gear check is the responsibility of the Team Manager.**
5. No riders other than those competing will be permitted to ride on the grounds.
6. The Release and Waiver of Liability must be signed by a parent/guardian of the rider and returned with the entry form.

### **TEAM SCORES**

- Points will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place
- The best 4 scores will be taken from each school
- The winning team receives a perpetual shield
- Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place for each section
- Team scores go toward an aggregate score at the end of the Victorian Interschool Series
