General Excellence Awards - Year 7 or Year 10 entry 2022

Applications

1. General Excellence Award applications are open to all students entering Year 7 or Year 10 in 2022.
2. General Excellence Award applications are open to external students and currently enrolled Ivanhoe Grammar School students.
3. Applications are to be submitted online via the Ivanhoe Grammar School website from November 2020.
4. The closing date for applications is 5pm Friday 26 March 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.
5. All applications are to be submitted online via the Ivanhoe Grammar School website. Hard copy applications will not be accepted.
6. A complete application is required. The following documents must be supplied at the time of application:
 - Two written references
 - Most recent school report
 - For students applying for the Year 7 2022 General Excellence Award - Year 3 Naplan results from 2018 – minimum Band 4 in each category
 - For students applying for the Year 10 2022 General Excellence Award - Year 7 Naplan results from 2019 – minimum Band 7 in each category
 - a recent photo
 - payment of the application fee

Interviews and Timeline

1. Applicants may be required to attend an interview at the School.
2. The School will be in touch to arrange the interview time.
4. Interviews will be held at Ivanhoe Grammar School commencing April 2021 and will continue through until the end of May 2021.
5. Due to the large number of applications received, it may take several weeks after the closing date to schedule all interviews.
6. Successful applicants will be notified in June 2021.

Conditions

1. General Excellence Awards offer a reduction of up to 50% of the tuition fees, for the duration of the student's secondary education. All other fees and charges are payable in full.
2. The School reserves the right not to offer an Award if the standard of those presenting does not warrant it doing so.
3. Recipients of Awards are expected to attain a generally high academic standard and the student should be actively involved in the various co-curricular activities of the School.
4. Periodic reviews of the Award will be conducted to verify satisfactory progress and participation. In exceptional circumstances the Award may be terminated by the Principal.
5. It is our expectation that recipients of the General Excellence Awards will complete their Secondary Education at Ivanhoe Grammar School. The School reserves the right to ask for reimbursement to the value of the Award if the student leaves the School prior to this time.
